UNION STEWARDS are your link to OPSEU. They work with you. They know you. You know them. So why not call upon them for help when you need it most at work??!!

OUR Stewards either have gone through or will have undergone through extensive educational training on how to be a more effective representative. They are in constant communication with the Local Executive Committee and therefore can express your views and concerns to the LEC more efficiently.

IDEALY, each work area should have a union steward present in order to effectively represent you. Remember, they are your link and information liaison between you and the Union. If your area requires a Steward, volunteer and get involved.

BECOMING a union steward is simple. Just make a request to your local president of your intentions and you will become officially elected at the next general membership meeting. This position affords opportunities and experiences that can directly build on your interpersonal & developmental skills.

FOR example, you can take educational courses on labour relations, attend and participate in several seminars/ conferences each year, sit on different sub-

Even by being informed of labour issues and workplace safety or attend the local's general meetings is Ask your local a start. stewards about any updates, progress or developments.
